

Data Processing Notice for the Operation of the FUA-NET Platform

1. The Data Controller and Contact Details

2. Purpose of Data Processing

The purpose of the FUA-NET platform is to support policy, planning and development cooperation related to Functional Urban Areas (FUA) within projects implemented under the Interreg Danube Region Programme associated with the European Union's cohesion policy.

The platform provides an opportunity for organisations and experts with experience in or interested in FUA-related topics to establish contact with one another, and to prepare and develop project partnerships.

3. Legal Basis for Data Processing

The primary legal basis for data processing is the performance of a task carried out in the public interest pursuant to **Article 6(1)(e) of the GDPR**. The data processing is necessary for the implementation and maintenance of projects carried out under the Interreg Danube Region Programme associated with the European Union's cohesion policy, in the course of which Lechner Tudásközpont Nonprofit Kft. performs a public task as lead partner.

The inclusion of data in the FUA-NET database and the sharing thereof with other registered users is based on the explicit, voluntary consent of the data subject pursuant to **Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR**.

4. Scope of Personal Data Processed

Of the personal data listed below, the processing of data necessary for the basic operation of the FUA-NET platform is based on the performance of a task carried out in the public interest pursuant to Article 6(1)(e) of the GDPR.

The sharing of data with other registered partners, as well as the processing of the data subject's direct contact details (in particular email address and telephone number), shall only take place on the basis of the data subject's voluntary consent.

The data subject's consent extends only to those data processing operations for which a separate checkbox is provided on the electronic form.

The following personal data shall be processed in the course of data processing:

- name;
- name of organisation;
- position;

- email address;
- telephone number (if provided by the data subject);
- country;
- municipality;
- information relating to professional field and experience;
- other supplementary information provided voluntarily by the data subject.

5. Duration of Data Processing

The data controller shall process personal data until the end of the project implementation and sustainability period, or until the data subject withdraws consent, taking into account the retention obligations applicable to EU projects.

6. Data Transfers, Data Processors

Personal data shall be accessible to registered users participating in the FUA-NET network only with the consent of the data subject, for the purpose of establishing partner relationships. The data shall not be transferred to third countries.

7. Rights of Data Subjects

Data subjects have the right to request access to, rectification, erasure or restriction of processing of personal data relating to them, to object to the processing, and to data portability in accordance with the conditions laid down in law.

The data subject may withdraw consent at any time, which shall not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out prior to the withdrawal.

8. Right to Lodge a Complaint

The data subject may lodge a complaint with the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information, and is entitled to seek judicial remedy.

9. Language of the Data Processing Notice

This data processing notice has been prepared in Hungarian. The English language version is for information purposes only; in case of discrepancy, the Hungarian language version shall prevail.
